







UK DCTN Steering Committee responsibilities for SpR Fellows



Responsibilities of the Steering Committee are as follows:

-  To review and comment on all study proposals submitted for consideration.
-  To make final recommendations to the Executive Committee on which proposals should be taken forward for external funding.
-  To make recommendations to the Executive Committee on which proposals are eligible for pump priming funds for further feasibility/pilot work.
-  To provide guidance for the aims and objectives of the Network.
-  To advertise and promote the Network whenever possible eg local dept meetings etc.
-  To make final decisions relating to HTA submissions for trials.

The Steering Group meet three times a year and members are expected to attend at least two meetings. Two of these meetings are usually held at BAD house in London, with the AGM being held within the annual BAD meeting. Meetings last for no more than a couple of hours and all travel expenses are paid.

The successful applicants will be assigned a mentor to come from within the existing Steering Committee members.
